Our district is adjusting instruction and providing small group interventions to address the areas that need improvement. Tier $I$ and Tier 2 interventions are in place to address specific skill areas. We are progress monitoring every other week in literacy using Acadience to monitor student progress. NWEA is our benchmark assessment used three times each year in September, January, and May to monitor student growth data in the areas of Reading and Math. Staff is routinely utilizing this data to adjust instruction.
