



EARLY COLLEGE TRANSFER PATH – GENERAL AA DEGREE

Students can earn an AA degree from Bay College as a part of this early college arrangement. An AA degree is designed for students intending to transfer to a four-year university. Careers pathways that this degree aligns with include education (teaching), social work, political science, social science (psychology, history), criminal justice, law, business administration, communications, and more. This degree is not intended for a student wishing to go into science, engineering, or math. Students wishing to pursue these fields are encouraged to participate in dual-enrollment.

Early college students begin their sophomore year by applying to the program. Upon acceptance, students will participate in an academic and career preparation program. During their junior year, students take general education courses that are highly transferrable and can be applied towards a variety of degrees and concentrations. During their sophomore and junior years, most early college courses will be offered at Bark River Harris High School. During their senior year, college courses will be predominantly taken either online or on Bay's campus. The fifth year will be entirely on Bay's campus.
